Sat. <24 [between lines]> Carver brought festoons. at fleet Ditch with M<sup>r</sup> Fitch about Alder[man] Nicholls wall that fell. Dind at y<sup>e</sup> Goat on pork. at Sir Ch. Wren. at Mans coffee house w<sup>th</sup> S<sup>r</sup> J Cutler. Stubbs. &c primat. audited y<sup>e</sup> Reference of Ld keeper. returnd home. Garways with M<sup>r</sup> Wild M<sup>r</sup> Hill M<sup>r</sup> Aubery. Dol Received from Sir Ch. Scarboro and paid me. 40sh[illings] for theater. making in all. 20<sup>ll</sup> [pounds]. writ to Bro[the]r.
